The Lancaster Virginia Historical Society is *dedicated to promoting and sharing honest and inclusive local history and genealogy*. Founded in 1958, our nonprofit organization was originally named the Mary Ball Washington Museum & Library, Inc., in honor of President George Washington's mother who was born and spent her youth in Lancaster County just a few miles from our location in the Court House village.

Our mission is to discover, collect, preserve, understand and interpret the history of Lancaster and surrounding counties of the Commonwealth of Virginia for the enjoyment and educational benefit of all residents, succeeding generations, and visitors, and for the vitality of the area, fulfilled through exhibits, programs, research and collaborative activities.

The Museum in the historic buildings of Lancaster House, the Old Jail, and Old Clerk's Office presents changing exhibits about local topics and showcases artifacts from our *collections and archives* such as household goods, clothing, portraits, photographs, letters, and other items spanning nearly more than three and a half centuries of area history.

The Genealogy & History Research Library contains thousands of books, periodicals, family genealogies, published county records, specialized indexes, and other research materials on Lancaster, the Northern Neck, and other locales in Virginia and nearby states. The nearby courthouse holds original county records, nearly intact since 1652.

The Museum Gift Shop & Bookstore offers a large selection of regional books and research publications, including the full-length history *Lancaster County, Virginia: Where the River Meets the Bay*, along with Virginia products, souvenirs, and heritage items.

Special events, educational activities, and public programs are held throughout the year and enjoyed by hundreds of participants of all ages.
